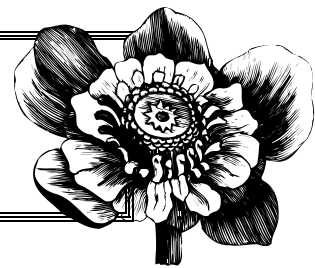


# FLOWERS, ARRANGEMENTS & POTTED PLANTS

### RULES AND INFORMATION:

- Limited to residents of Mariposa County and Eastern Madera County (east of Madera Canal).
- Judging will be closed.
- Exhibits in this division must have been grown by exhibitor within exhibitor's county of residence, except for arrangements.
- With the exception of miniature arrangements, all containers must be marked with name of exhibitor where it will not be seen. Building attendants will furnish all possible protection; the fair is not responsible for any liability for loss or damage to the property of exhibitor.
- Cut flowers must have their own foliage, except in arrangements. Spent blooms should be removed.
- Whole exhibits or portions of exhibits may not be entered in more than one class.
- All fresh flowers and foliage must be in water. Watering of potted plants is sole responsibility of exhibitor.
- Any plants showing evidence of parasites or disease will be disqualified by the department head at the time they are brought to the fairgrounds
