### ENTRIES:

- **Entry Forms Accepted through Saturday, August 3, 2024 by 5 PM.**
- **NO ENTRIE FEES: SWEEPSTAKE AWARDS ONLY**
- Exhibits to fair on Wednesday, August 28, 2024, between 1 – 7 PM
- Exhibits picked up on Monday September 2, 2024, from 6:30 - 7:30PM or Tuesday September 3, 2024, from 8 am-12 Noon

### RULES AND INFORMATION:

- Limited to residents of Mariposa County and Eastern Madera County (east of Madera Canal).
- Judging will be closed.
- Exhibitor MAY bring two identical jars for each entry if they wish. If two jars are brought, one will be opened and judged; the other will be displayed during the fair. Jars that have been judged may be picked up on Thursday, August 31, 2023, after the judging has been completed.
- All entries in this division must have been preserved by the exhibitor within 12 months of the opening day of fair. Items which have been shown at any previous Mariposa County Fair are not eligible. All products which have not been eliminated from consideration will be opened.
- Standard canning jars must be used. Standard jars are a container specifically designed for canning purposes. NO PARAFFIN SEALS. All canning must be in sealed jars.
- All non-acid foods must be canned UNDER PRESSURE. Please put ingredients and date made on a label on the jar.

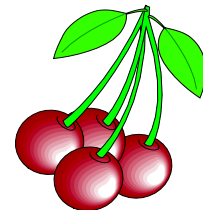

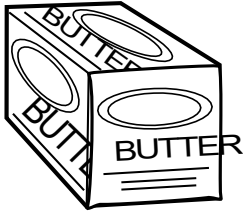
