- Exhibits in this division shall have been made or created by exhibitor (except collections) and completed within the last 12 months preceding the fair and must not have been previously exhibited at a Mariposa County Fair.
- Large items requiring more than three square feet of exhibit space will be accepted on a space available basis and have prior approval by fair management no later than August 3, 2024.
- Picture is framed with screw eyes and wire, ready to hang. Wall hanging is unframed but has a usable hanger
