2025 MARIPOSA COUNTY FAIR & HOMECOMING JUNIOR LIVESTOCK DEPARTMENT INDEPENDENT EXHIBITOR PROGRAM (ALL SPECIES)

Welcome to the Mariposa Fair Junior Livestock Independent Exhibitor Program. Included here are your required forms and record book forms for 2025. Please make sure that you read the State and Local rules for the Mariposa Fair & Homecoming. These requirements are for ALL Independent Exhibitors in the Junior Livestock Department at the 2025 Mariposa Fair.

QUALIFICATIONS FROM LOCAL RULES

Livestock classes are open to members of 4-H clubs and FFA chapters located in Mariposa County. Independent Exhibitors must be residents of Mariposa County and/or Students of Mariposa School District.

QUALIFICATIONS FROM STATE RULES

VII, Exhibitor Age Requirements 4 - Independent exhibitors must be at least 9 years old by January 1, 2025 to compete in large animal (Beef, Sheep, Swine, Dairy Cattle, Dairy Goats, Boer Goats, Market & Fiber Goats, Horse, Alpaca & Llama) competitions at California Fairs. Exhibitors are eligible to compete/exhibit through December 31st of the year in which they turn 19 years of age. Youth may be ineligible to participate as Independent if documented disciplinary action involving their project(s) has been taken against them by 4-H, FFA or Grange organizations. Length of ineligibility to be determined by Fair Management.

VII Exhibit Eligibility 5 – Juniors who have been 4-H, FFA or Grange project members within 60 days (120 days for horse and market beef) prior to the fair are not eligible to compete in that project as Independent exhibitors or enter project(s) under a different organization.

VII Exhibit Eligibility 6 - All junior exhibitors must have project management records and proof of supervision available as to the length of the project.

VII Exhibit Eligibility 7 - Independent junior exhibitors entering market animals must provide Fair Management with a picture of their animal, appropriate proof of ownership, permanent tag, tattoo and/or hog ear notch information 120 days prior to the fair for beef and 60 days prior to the fair for sheep, swine, and goats.

VII Exhibit Eligibility 8 - All junior exhibitors must have "on ground" supervision by a responsible adult.

Requirements for eligible Independent Exhibitors are as follows:

• Must turn in Independent Application, signed by both exhibitor and parent no later than:

o Beef: May 1, 2025

Swine, Sheep and Goats: June 30, 2025Rabbits and Poultry: July 30, 2025

- Must submit a copy of birth certificate for exhibitor with the Independent Application if this is the first time showing.
- Copy of bill of sale and a front, right side, left side and rear picture of the animal with the
 exhibitor must be included with the Independent application. Picture must be colored and
 show any ear tag numbers and/or ear notching.
- All exhibitors are required to complete the Youth for the Quality Care of Animals
 (www.yqca.org) program online prior to the fair entry deadline of August 2, 2025. If completing in a classroom environment, the exhibitor must still present a copy of the certificate.
- Fill out and submit Mariposa Fair & Homecoming Livestock entry forms (either via online entries (if available) or handwritten forms), along with the appropriate payment(s), by the entry deadline of August 2, 2025 at 5:00 PM.
- Independent exhibitors are required to purchase liability insurance coverage through the Fair
 Office at the time of fair entry. The fee is \$5.00 per exhibitor regardless of species exhibited or
 the number of entries. If multiple entry forms are submitted, the insurance fee is only paid
 once.
- Exhibitors shall be supervised AT ALL TIMES while caring for or showing their animal(s) at the
 Fair by a parent or guardian. Independent exhibitors will be solely responsible for the feeding,
 care and cleaning of pens for their own exhibits.
- Independent exhibitors are required to attend a meeting set by the Fair with their parent or guardian in attendance. The time and location will be announced after the close of entries. (Should be August 12, 2025 but check with the fair office at time of entry). Independent exhibitors are expected to abide by rules as set forth by the Fair concerning all Livestock exhibitors. Independent exhibitors should be familiar with State and Local rules for the Mariposa Fair & Homecoming, as well as the rules for the Junior Livestock Auction.

This affidavit must be completed on both sides and turned into the fair office along with a photograph of the project animals as follows to be accepted:

No Later than: 120 days before opening day of fair for beef, horses.

60 days before opening day of fair for sheep, swine and goats.
30 days before opening day of fair for pigeons, poultry, rabbits.

THE PROJECT MANAGEMENT RECORD MUST BE COMPLETE AND AVAILABLE DURING THE FAIR FOR REVIEW.

THE UNDERSIGNED CERTIFIED THAT:

- 1. The livestock entry (entries) entered were under the exhibitor's sole ownership, care and management for at least 120 days prior to the opening day of fair for beef, horses, 60 days for sheep, swine and goats and 30 days for pigeons, poultry, rabbits.
 - Further, that the exhibitor has not been a member of a junior division organization (4H, FFA or Grange) within the last 120 days for beef, horses, 60 days for swine, sheep and goats and 30 days for pigeons, poultry, rabbits prior to the opening date of the fair.
- 2. That exhibitor has on ground supervision by a responsible adult. Exhibitor must have project management records and proof of supervision available as to length of project.
- That the undersigned has read and has a full understanding of the rules and regulations governing the fair and agrees to abide by them.

2. The withdrawal time required of any medication (including medicated feeds) or pesticide administered has been adhered to. As the owner of the market animal, I acknowledge I will be responsible for my animal if it is rejected at a processing center due to the presence of drug residues. If drug residue is detected I may be liable to the buyer for an amount equal to three times the purchase price and may also be liable for attorney's fees and civil penalties (Food and Agriculture Code §14363).
