Upon submittal of the agreement for entry, exhibitors (including agents and junior exhibitors' parents, leaders, and advisors) acknowledge and agree to the following principles for competition:

- 1. Exhibitors will comply with printed Fair and State rules and accept responsibility for their exhibits.
- 2. Exhibitors will indemnify the Fair and the State of California from any loss resulting from rules enforcement.
- 3. Exhibitors must be able to prove their own eligibility and that of their exhibits according to fair rules and acknowledge that misrepresentation of any kind is prohibited.
- 4. Junior exhibitors are expected to prepare, manage, and present their own exhibits.
- 5. Exhibitors will conduct themselves with sportsmanship, integrity, and cooperation with all participants.
