- Entry Forms Accepted through or Post Marked by Saturday, August 3, 2024, by 5 PM or 11:59 PM ONLINE.
- MUST HAVE A BILL OF SALE WITH ENTRY.
- ETHICS CERTICATE (YQCA) MUST BE ATTACHED WITH ENTRY. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Entry fee: \$5.00 per entry.
- Check In Time: Animals in place by Thursday August 29, 2024, between 1-8 PM.
- Weigh in: Immediately after 9 AM Junior Exhibitor Meeting, Friday, August 30, 2024, starting with Swine, Goats, Lambs & Beef
- Judging: Friday, August 30, 2024, beginning at 5:30 PM
- Swine Released: Monday, September 2, 2024, at 6:00 PM

#### ANIMAL CARE PROGRAM INFORMATION (PROP 12):

#### Fairs and Exhibition Guidance (ca.gov)

ATTENTION: As of January 1, 2022, all commercial breeding pigs in California are required to be raised in compliance with Animal Confinement minimum standards. To ensure pork meat from the show pig has access to a "resale" market, ask for self-certification or third-party certification confirming that the commercial breeding pig (dam of the show pig) was kept in compliance with Animal Confinement minimum standards.

- Without written documentation that the show pig is an immediate offspring of a breeding pig kept in compliance with Animal Confinement, then pork meat from the show pig will not have access to the "resale" market after the fair.
- The buyer of show pigs who processes the pigs as pork meat to be sold into the retail market in California will want this written documentation.

## **RULES AND INFORMATION:**

ATTENTION all swine exhibitors: at the request of Yosemite Meats, our swine harvester, they would like all swine going through the Junior Livestock Auction to have AT LEAST 5/8" of hair. All exhibitors need to keep that in mind when grooming their animals

- Swine animals must be shown in a Natural State. Exhibitors are allowed to clip their animals.
- No wash racks at the fair.
- Exhibitors who need to separate animals in the same pen are to provide own dividing panels
- Lick-its are not available in every pen. Exhibitors to provide own feed and water containers as needed

#### AWARDS:

• American System of Judging

**Market Acceptable:** U.S. No. 1 and No. 2 hogs of average or greater conformation that are acceptable in leanness, muscularity and production traits.

**Not Market Acceptable:** Any hog of below average conformation including U.S. No. 3, U.S. No. 4 and utility grade hogs.

**4H:** Dark Blue Jeans. <u>NO</u> hip huggers or low-rise jeans/pants. Solid white dress shirts, long or short sleeved, collared, button or snap front. Shirt must be tucked into pants. <u>NO</u> tee shirts or sleeveless shirts/tops. Official Tie or Scarf. 4H Hat must be on head during showing and auction.

**FFA:** White Jeans. <u>NO</u> hip huggers or low-rise jeans/pants. Solid white dress shirts, long or short sleeved, collared, button or snap front. Shirt must be tucked into pants. <u>NO</u> tee shirts or sleeveless shirts/tops. Official Tie or Scarf. FFA Jacket.
