RULES AND INFORMATION:

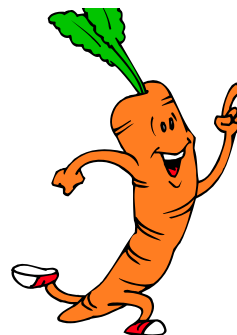
- Limited to residents of Mariposa County and Eastern Madera County (east of Madera Canal).
